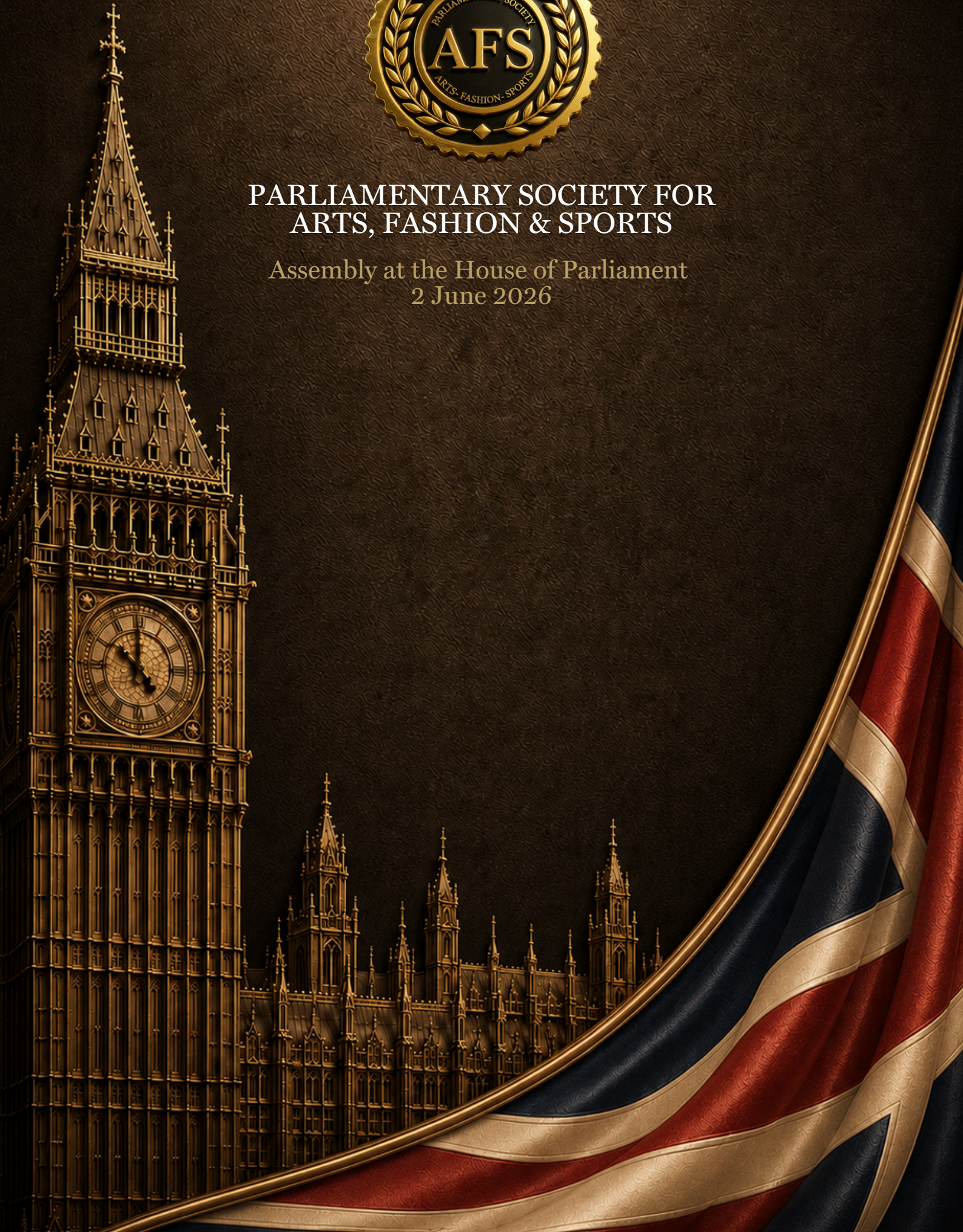

Today's gathering stands as both a continuation and an evolution of our advocacy at the Parliamentary Society for Arts, Fashion, and Sports. It is not only a moment of recognition, but a statement of intent. We come together to honour individuals whose creative work has shaped culture, influenced thought, and contributed meaningfully to a better world, while also addressing one of the most urgent and complex challenges facing our industry: violence within the arts.

Since 2019, the Parliamentary Society has worked tirelessly to support the arts community. Although we are not a politically affiliated organisation, we are parliamentary in the truest sense of the word — existing for the people, encouraging dialogue across sectors, and working horizontally to bring together voices from all backgrounds in pursuit of positive cultural change.

In 2026, this dual purpose feels more critical than ever. As the creative industries continue to expand globally — economically, culturally, and digitally — we must ensure that progress is not measured solely by output or revenue, but also by the conditions in which creativity is produced. Recognition and responsibility must move hand in hand. Each year, our assemblies and publications confront defining societal issues. Reports and cross-sector research continue to highlight the intersection between violence, mental health challenges, and substance misuse. These are not isolated issues; they are deeply interconnected and often exacerbated by the very environments in which creative work takes place. The creative mind thrives on intensity, exploration, and emotional depth. Traits such as novelty-seeking, heightened sensitivity, and a pursuit of stimulation are often catalysts for innovation. However, without the appropriate structures of care, these same traits can increase vulnerability. The line between creative brilliance and personal risk can become dangerously thin when support systems are absent or insufficient.

In today's landscape, the conversation must move beyond awareness and into action. We must build frameworks that prioritise wellbeing, establish accountability, and create safe, inclusive spaces where individuals are empowered to speak without fear. Silence can no longer be the cost of participation within our industries. At the same time, it is vital that we continue to celebrate those who embody the very best of what creativity can achieve. The individuals we recognise today are not only exceptional in their fields; they are catalysts for positive change. Through art, fashion, music, media, and storytelling, they challenge perceptions, elevate voices, and inspire progress. They remind us that creativity is not passive — it is a force capable of shaping societies and shifting narratives.

Our responsibility, therefore, is twofold: to protect and to uplift. To ensure that the environments in which creativity flourishes are as strong and supportive as the work itself. And to champion those who use their platforms not only to succeed, but to serve.

As we look ahead, let this moment mark a renewed commitment — not only to excellence, but to integrity, safety, and collective responsibility. Because creativity, at its core, is a force for good. And when guided with purpose, it has the power to build a future that is not only brighter, but fairer, safer, and more secure for all.

Our Honourable Guest Speaker



Alex Davies-Jones, Member of Parliament for Pontypridd and Former Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State for Victims

Alex Davies-Jones MP is a Welsh Labour politician who has served as the Member of Parliament for Pontypridd since 2019. Recognised as a passionate advocate for justice, safeguarding, and equality, she has become an influential voice in British politics, particularly in the areas of victim protection and violence prevention.

Born and raised in Wales, Alex was brought up with strong community values and a deep understanding of social responsibility. The daughter of a miner, she studied Law and Politics at Cardiff University before beginning her career in public service, working in parliamentary research and communications roles for organisations including the Royal Institute of Chartered Surveyors and Dŵr Cymru Welsh Water.

From 2024 to 2026, Alex served as Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State for Victims at the Ministry of Justice under Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer. During her tenure, she led key areas of policy relating to Violence Against Women and Girls (VAWG), victims and witnesses, rape and serious sexual offences, criminal law, safeguarding, and public protection. Her ministerial responsibilities also included oversight of the Criminal Injuries Compensation Authority, coroners, and death management policy.

Widely respected for her commitment to tackling online abuse, misogyny, and violence against women, Alex has consistently championed safer communities and stronger protections for vulnerable individuals. Her work has focused not only on legislative reform but also on promoting greater awareness, inclusion, and support for victims across society.

Today, Alex Davies-Jones continues to play an important role in Parliament, bringing a strong and compassionate voice to national conversations surrounding justice, equality, and public safety.

Use of the Bell and Gavel

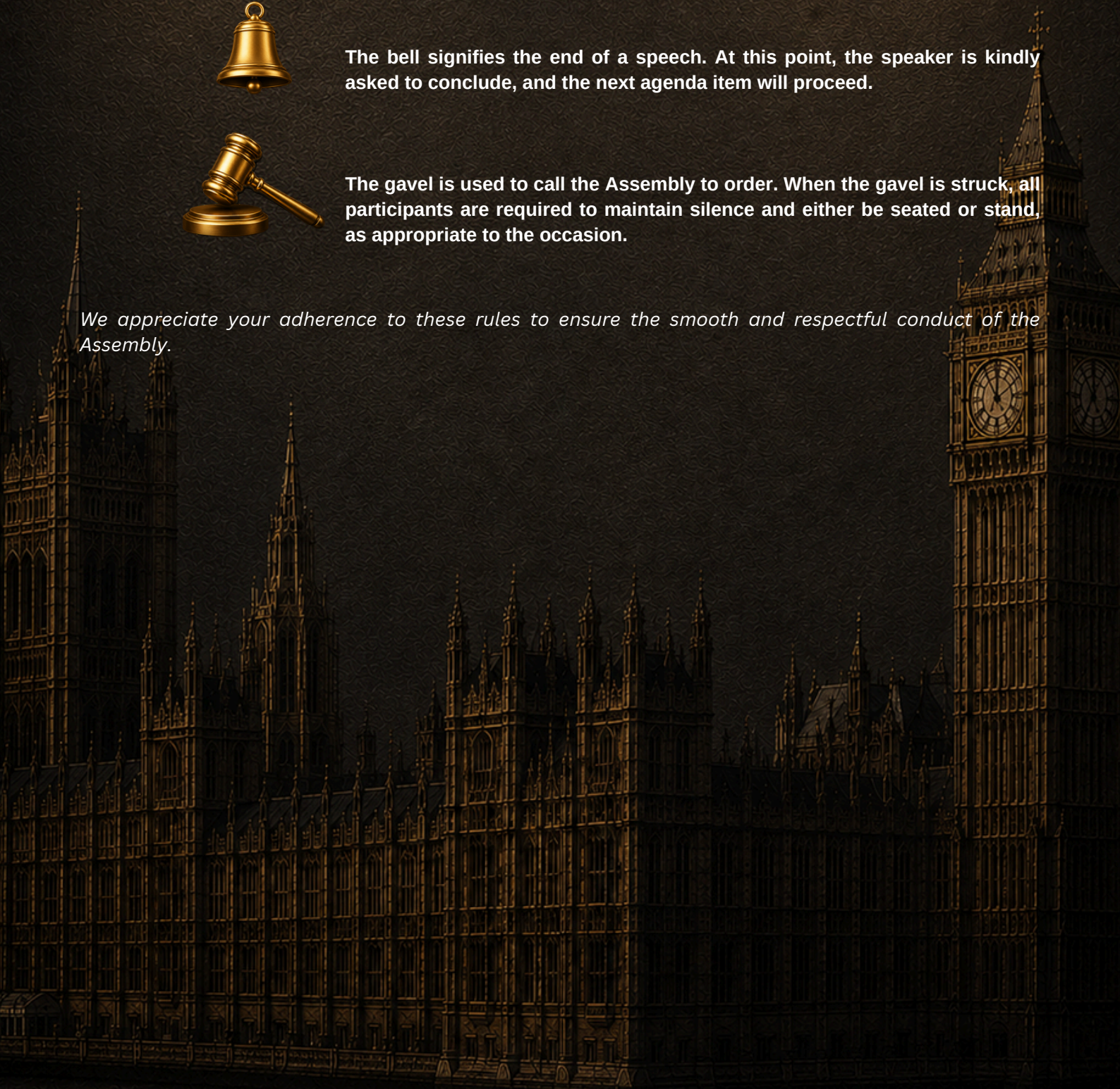


The bell signifies the end of a speech. At this point, the speaker is kindly asked to conclude, and the next agenda item will proceed.

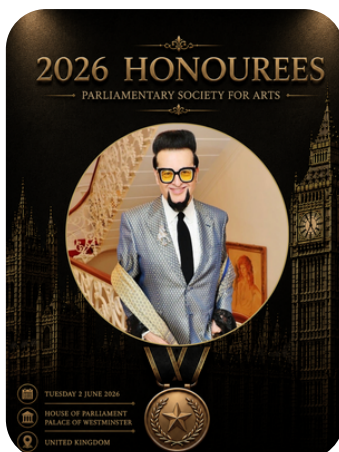
